**Re: GCSE Results Day  
Thursday 21<sup>st</sup> August 2025**

Pupils are to collect GCSE/FS/BTEC results from 9.30am – 12pm on the above date, please come to main reception for access to the building.

If collecting on behalf of the pupil, signed consent from the student is required. This should say -

“I ..... give permission for ..... to collect my GCSE results on my behalf”

Exam results will only be available on 21<sup>st</sup> August 2025. Candidates who do not collect their results on the day will have to wait until school reopens on Wednesday 3<sup>rd</sup> September 2025.

Following receipt of results, Parents/Carers who wish to make an appeal should do so in writing, stating the details of the complaint and the reasons for the appeal.

This should be done within 7 working days and received in writing by Tuesday 2<sup>nd</sup> September 2024, addressed to Mrs C Mitchell, Headteacher.

Written consent is required by the candidate before we are able to start this process.

Should there be a query on a mark/grade awarded by an Awarding Board please contact the exams officer via email on [exams@larches.lancs.sch.uk](mailto:exams@larches.lancs.sch.uk) (who will contact the subject teacher) as soon as possible.

Students should be aware that this can result in results/grades being raised, confirmed or lowered. Written consent is required by the candidate before we are able to start this process. There will be a fee incurred for this service.

## GCSE Results Support

The big day has finally arrived; hopefully all that hard work has paid off. Here is some support if it has or sadly, haven't gone your way. The best advice is to go to the college, training provider or employer you want to attend and show them your results and see how they can support you.

Make sure you think about your decision and talk it through with parents/carers.

Take your results with you and some form of ID – passport, NI number, birth certificate

**Results are what you wanted/expected:** Go to the college you would like to go to taking with you your results sheet and any other ID you have. Enrol on the course you really want to do.

**Didn't get your Maths and /or English:** Go to the college you would like to go to and see if it is possible to still do the course. Most colleges will be able to offer you a course or alternative provision.

**You don't want to go to college now but do an Apprenticeship:** the colleges that support apprenticeships are Preston College, Runshaw College and Myerscough College. There are Training Providers that also have lists of apprenticeships available and you can register for the [www.apprenticeships.gov.uk](http://www.apprenticeships.gov.uk) site.
